**Extended Deadline for Abstracts and Registration**

Dear Colleagues,

we are pleased to invite you to the XIVth “Workshop Aggression” that will be held at Freie Universität Berlin and Technische Universität Berlin, Germany, from November 6th - 8th, 2009. The main topic of this years’ Workshop Aggression is “Developmentally Appropriate Prevention and Intervention of Aggression” – but keeping with the tradition of the previous meetings, the workshop will provide a forum to present current research from all areas of basic and applied aggression research. Additionally, we scheduled a variety of workshops designed to offer applied instructions concerning the administration of a variety of preventive and intervention programs designed for children and adolescents (e.g., programs such as fairplayer.manual, fairplayer.sport, dialogue for shared meaning, as well as workshops concerning anti-aggression and anti-bullying strategies).

We are delighted to announce that three internationally renowned researchers in the field of prevention and intervention, Prof. Dr. Gil Gabriel Noam (Harvard Medical School, USA), Prof. Dr. John Lochman, (University of Alabama, USA), and Dr. Tina Malti (Harvard Medical School, USA) have accepted our invitation to present their work at this years’ workshop. As every year, contributions are invited that present new and ongoing work in all areas of aggression research of both theoretical and empirical nature. We welcome submissions of symposia and individual papers. English is the preferred conference language, but papers in German will also be accepted.

A special issue (edited by Herbert Scheithauer, Freie Universität Berlin, Germany, Tina Malti, Harvard Medical School, USA, and Gil Gabriel Noam, Harvard Medical School, USA) of the European Journal of Developmental Science ([www.ejds.net](http://www.ejds.net)) is devoted to the main topic of this years’ workshop, including studies which will be presented at this years’ Workshop Aggression.

In addition there will be a series of praxis oriented workshops offered by internationally renowned practitioners conveying the application of intervention and prevention programs of aggressive behavior.
